Established in 1974 by former President, Richard Nixon, National Volunteer Week has grown exponentially in scope each year since, drawing the support and endorsement of all subsequent U.S. presidents, governors, mayors and other respected elected officials. United Way of Larimer County's Volunteer Center has extended National Volunteer Week to take place throughout the entire month of April to include numerous local events, and to continue to promote volunteerism throughout the whole year.
